



Pelvic Ultrasound Prep

Dr. _____ scheduled you for a pelvic ultrasound on _____ at the _____ office.

A pelvic ultrasound uses sound waves to produce pictures of the organs and structures in your lower abdomen/pelvis.

You should wear comfortable loose-fitting clothing for your ultrasound exam. You may be asked to remove some clothing to be examined.

You are required to have a FULL bladder for this exam:

- **Drink 32 ounces of water 1 Hour prior to your exam.**

Billing

After our technician performs your ultrasound, it is sent to a board certified Radiologist for the results to be interpreted and reported to your physician at GI Specialists. GI Specialists will bill your insurance for the 'technical' component of the ultrasound (our technician performing the ultrasound) and **Quantum Radiology** will bill your insurance for the Radiologist that interprets the ultrasound.
